SEQUENCING

AGE
3-4

- Needs prompting and support to sequence a story (retell) with some details
- Can talk about what happened using 4 words
- Begins to have a clearer sense of time
- Answers simple WH questions

AGE
4-5

- Can sequence/retell a simple story with key details with prompting and support
- Can use 4+ words in a sentence
- Starts to use future tense
- Asks and answers questions with prompting
- Understands and use words for time/order like first, next, then, last
- Uses words like yesterday, today, tomorrow

THE STEPS

Needs prompting to sequence with some details

Sequences using key details with support

Uses temporal words when sequencing

Retells with all story grammar parts

Comprehends

Attention, Working Memory, Conceptual Knowledge
